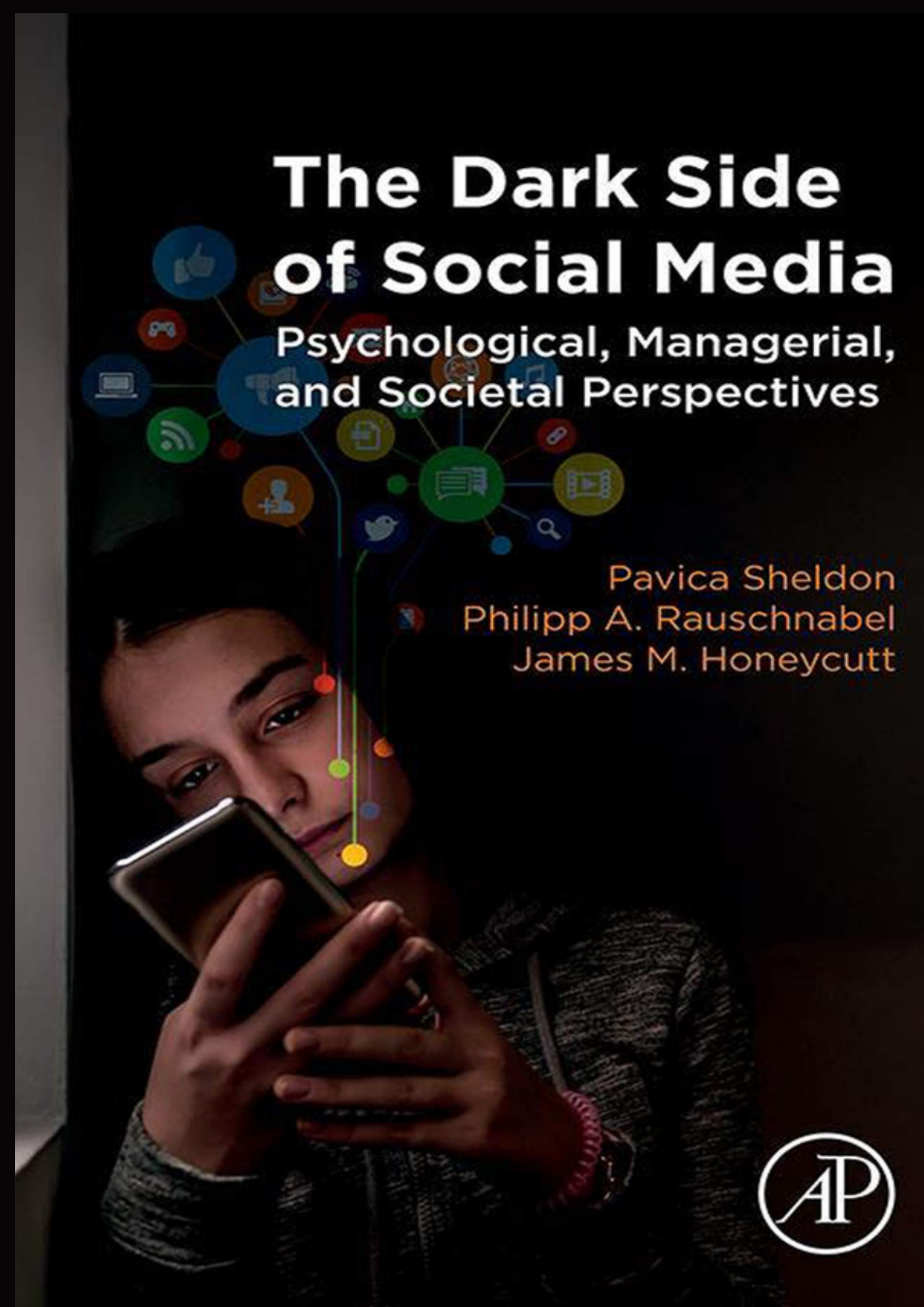


THE DARK SIDE OF SOCIAL MEDIA
