

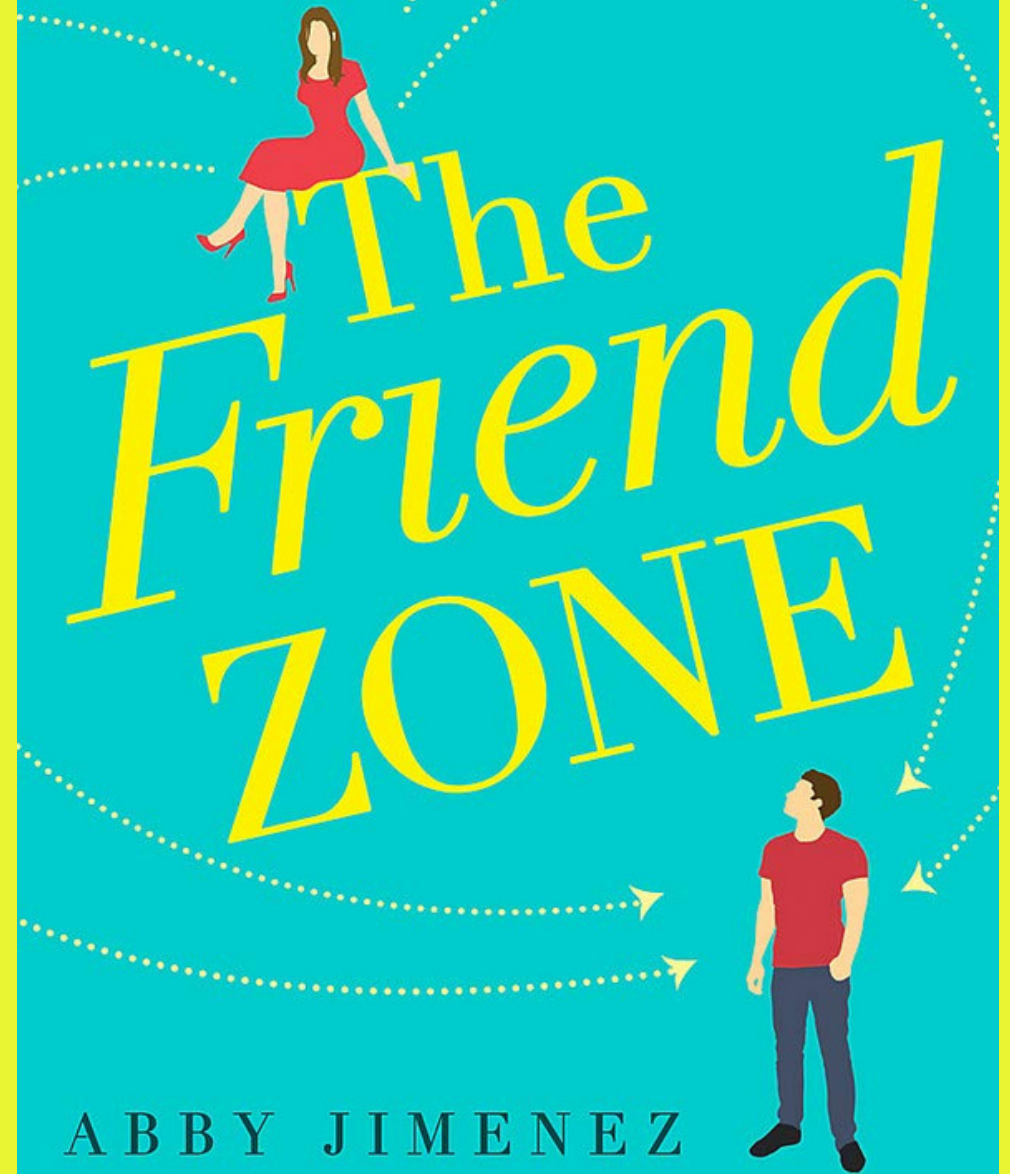
THE FRIEND ZONE

THE NIGHT SHE DISAPPEARED

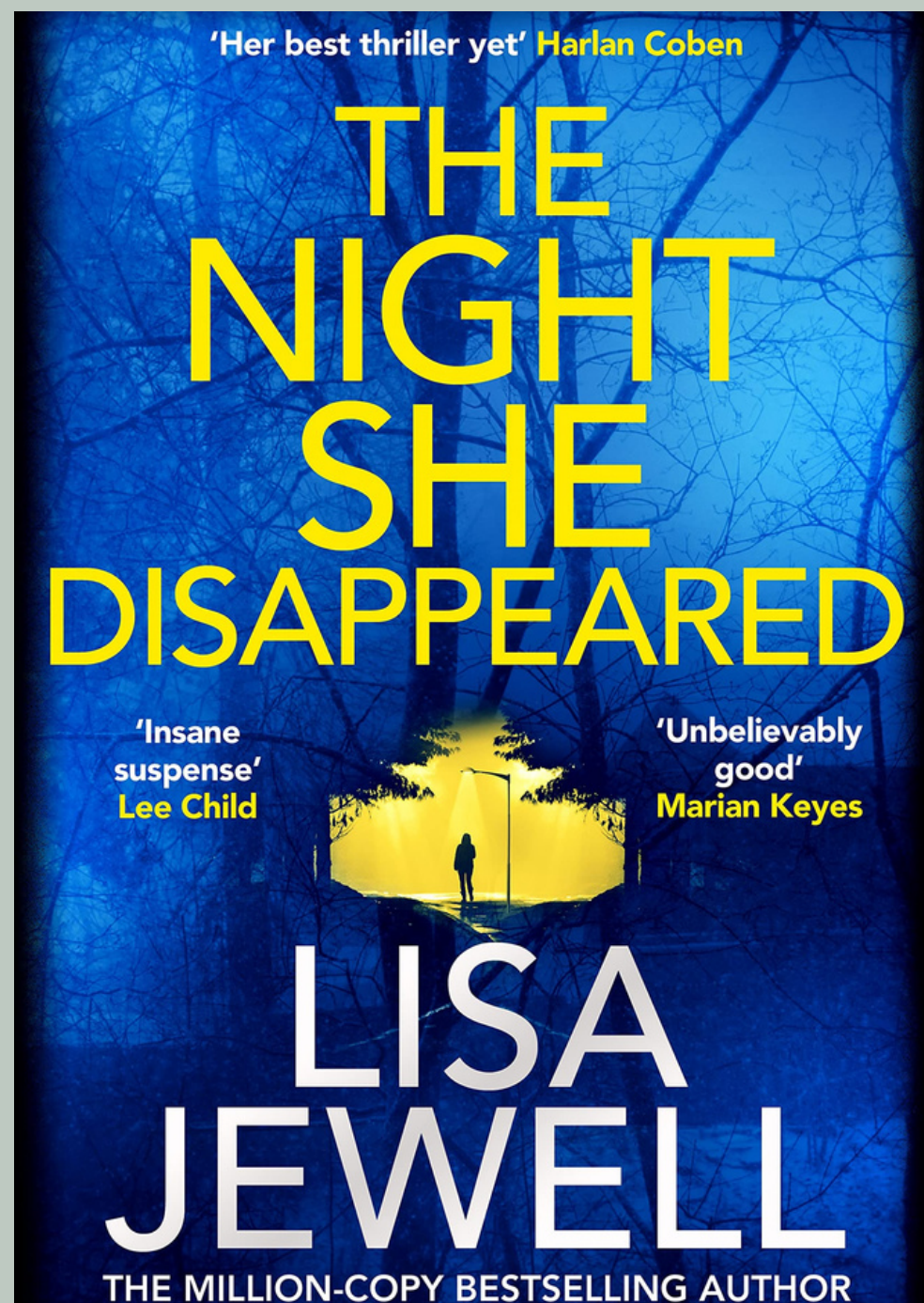

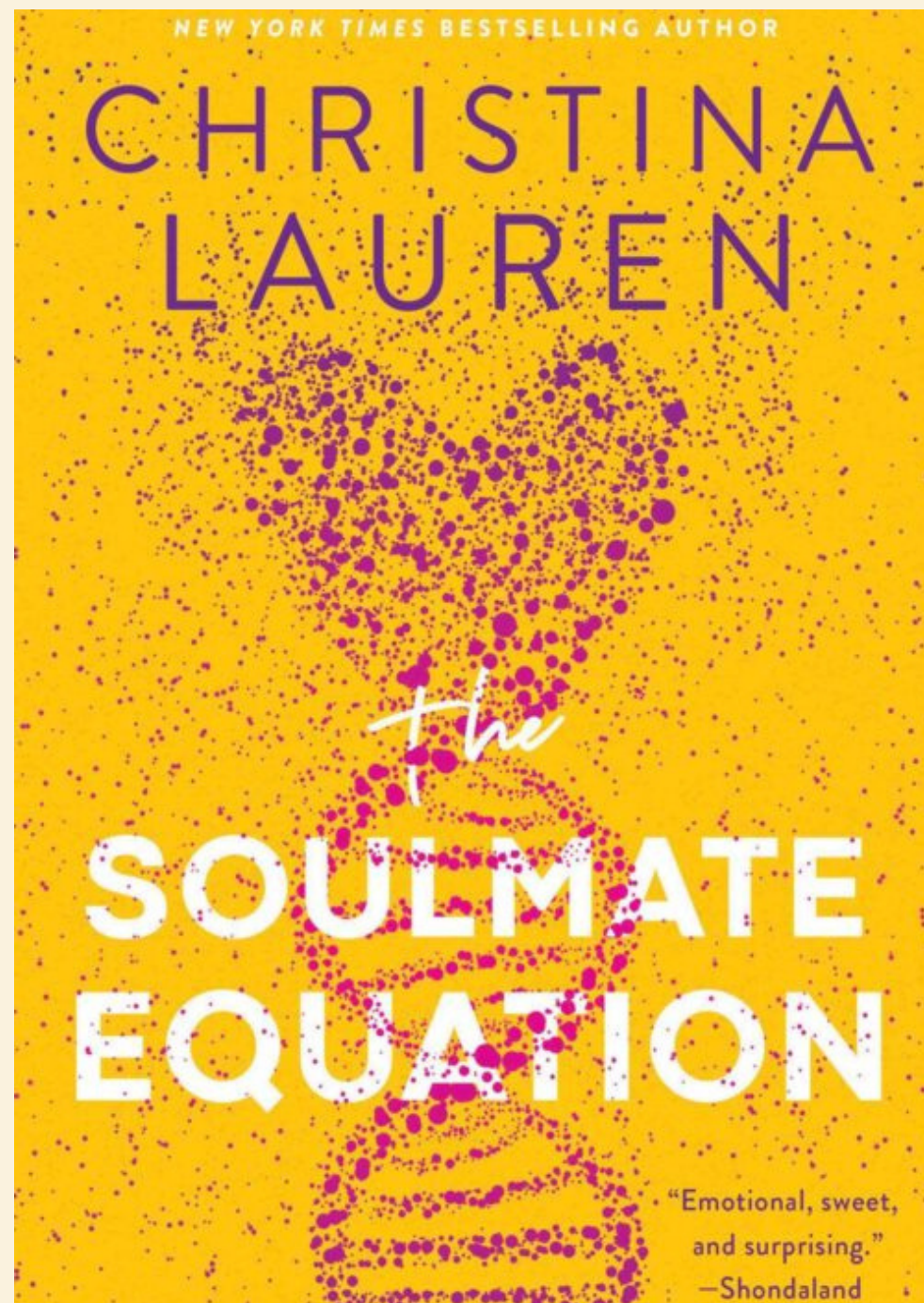
THE SOULMATE EQUATION

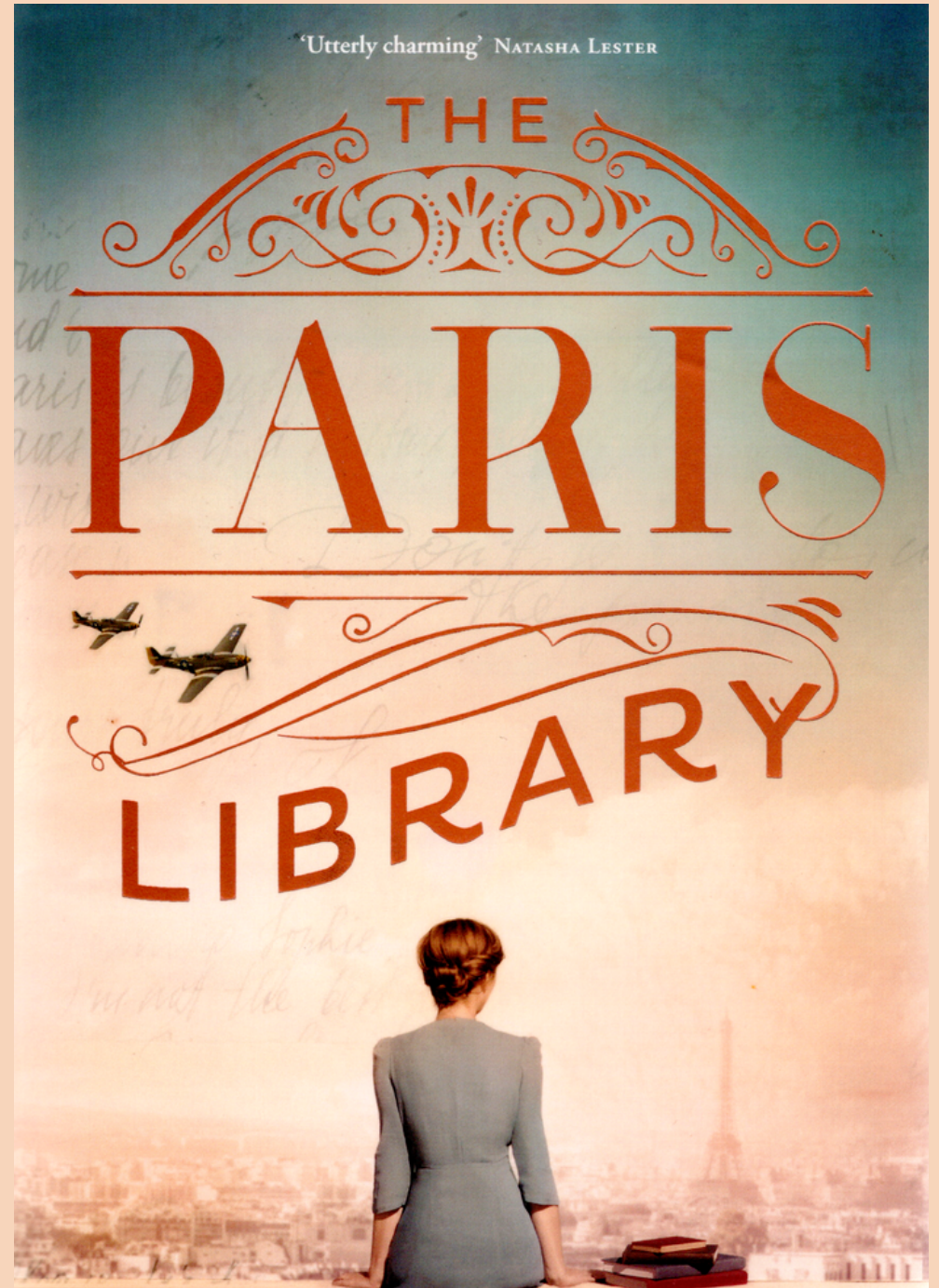

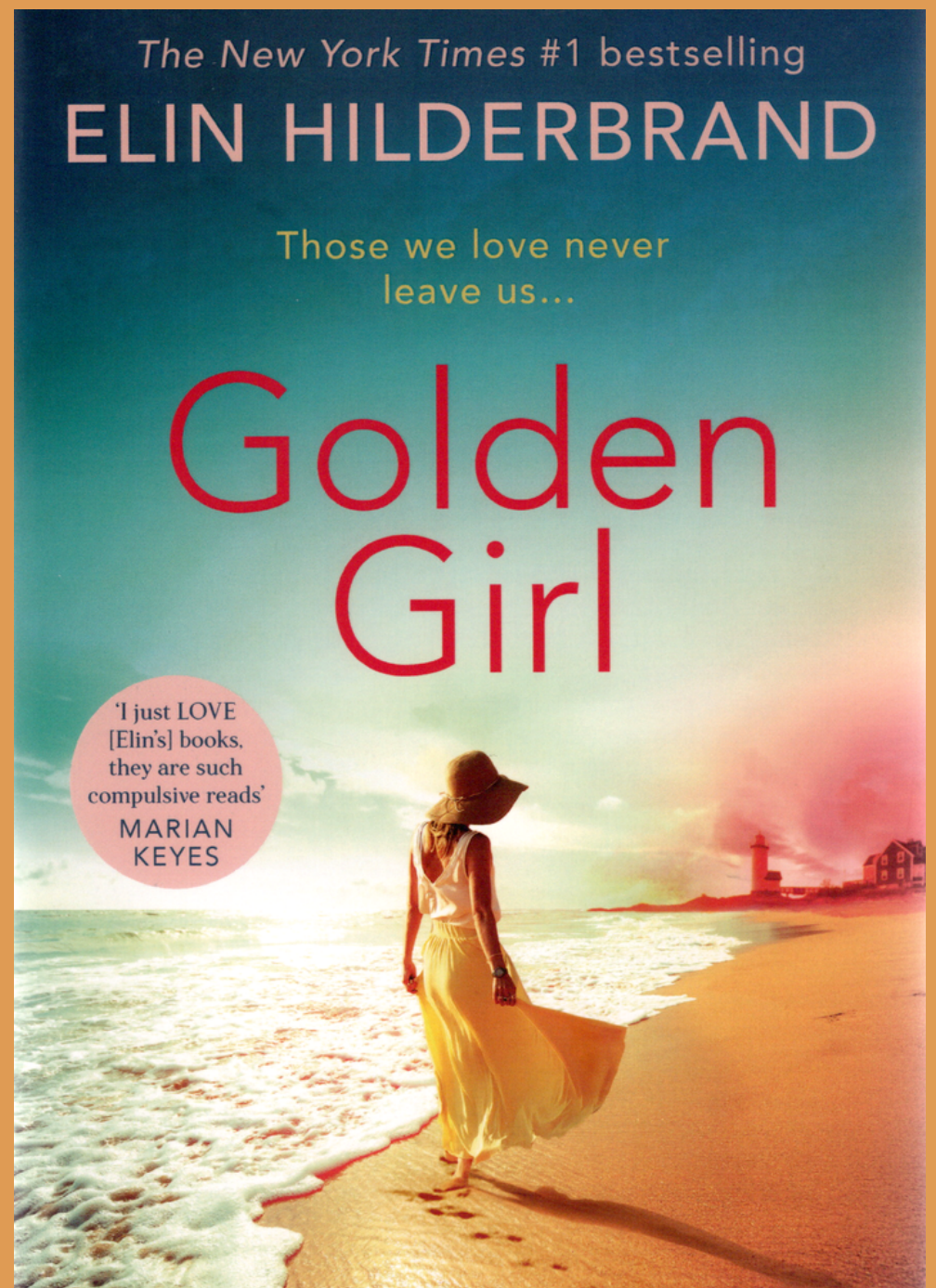

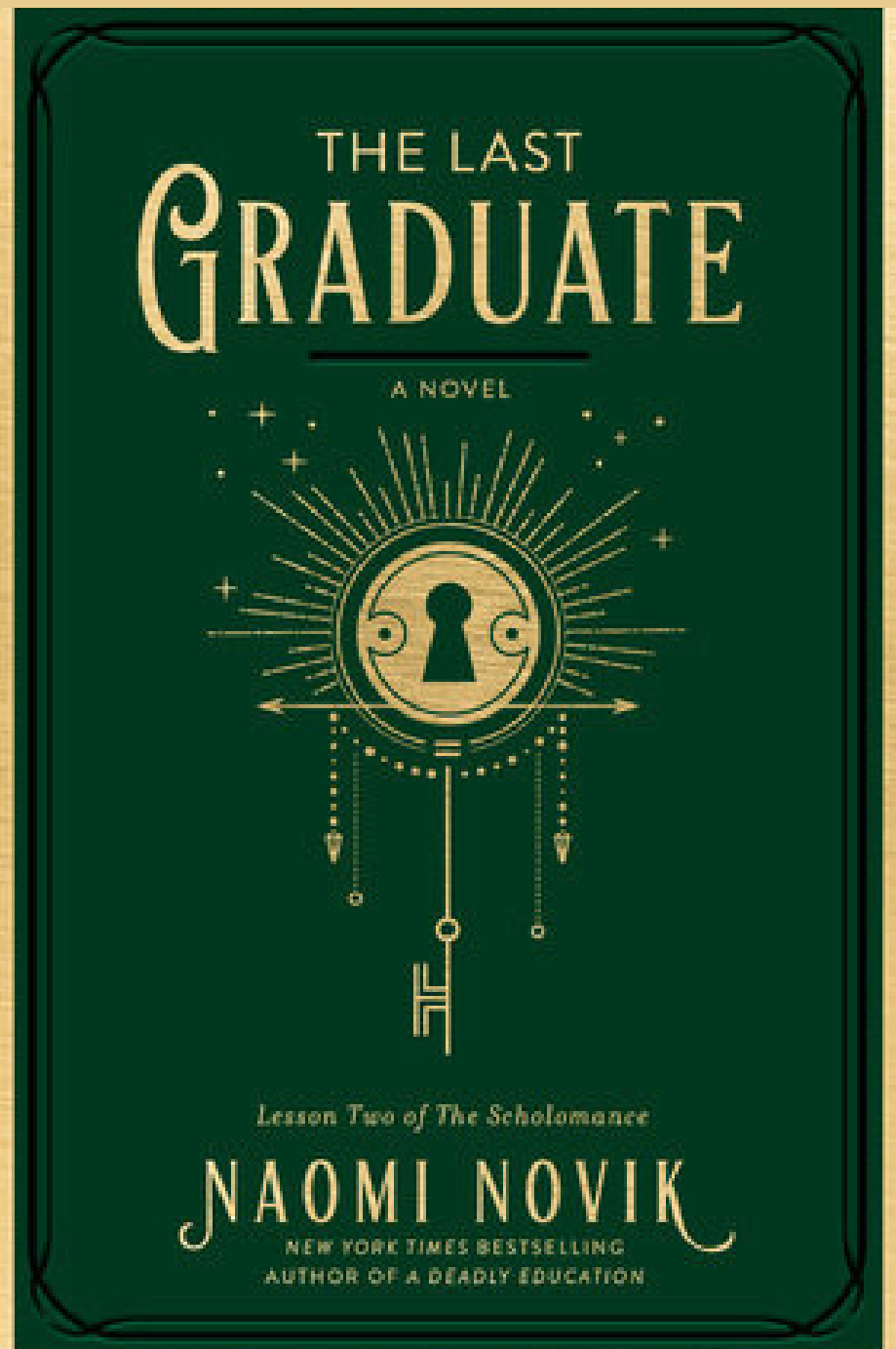
