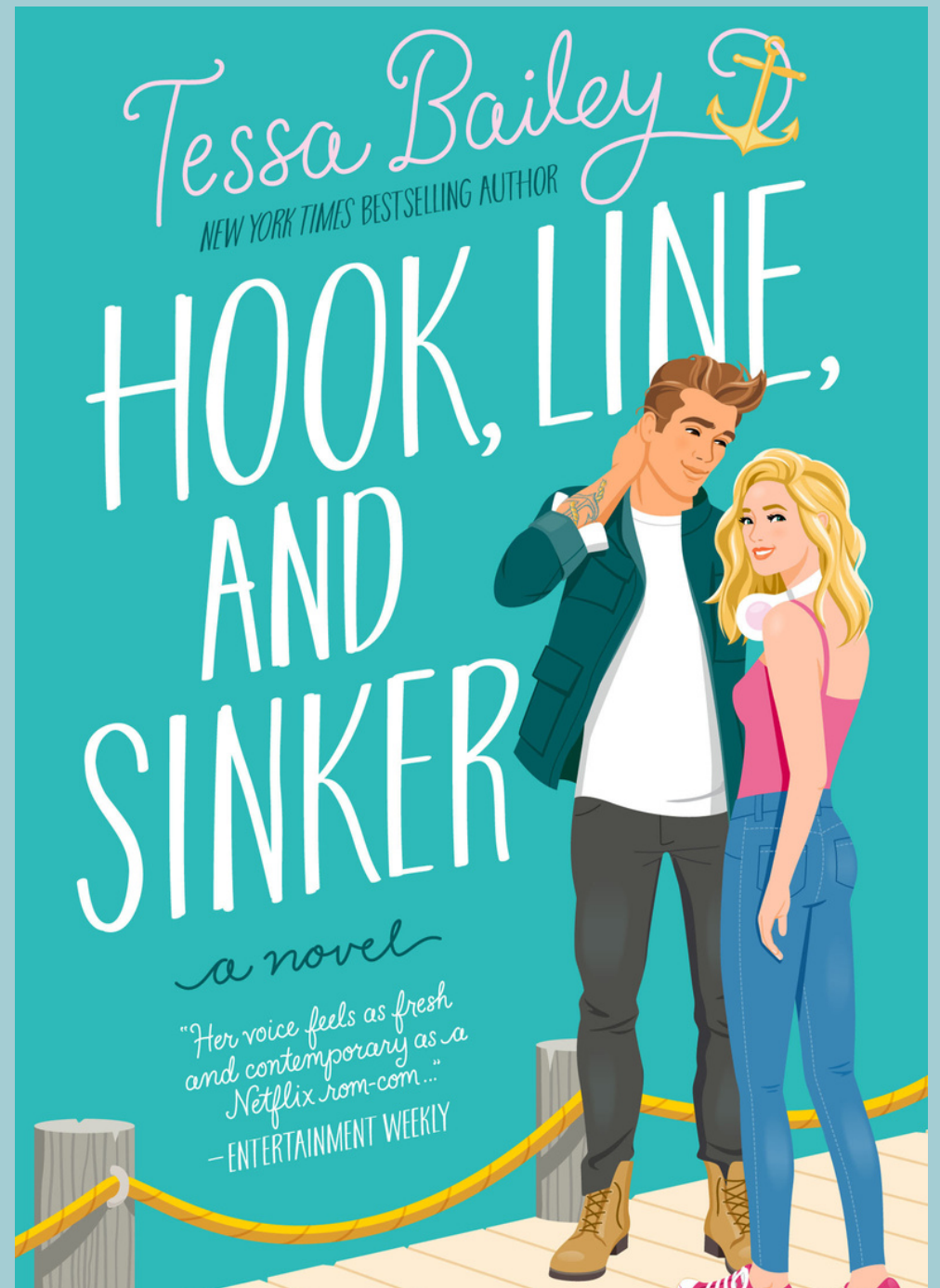


HOOK, LINE, AND SINKER

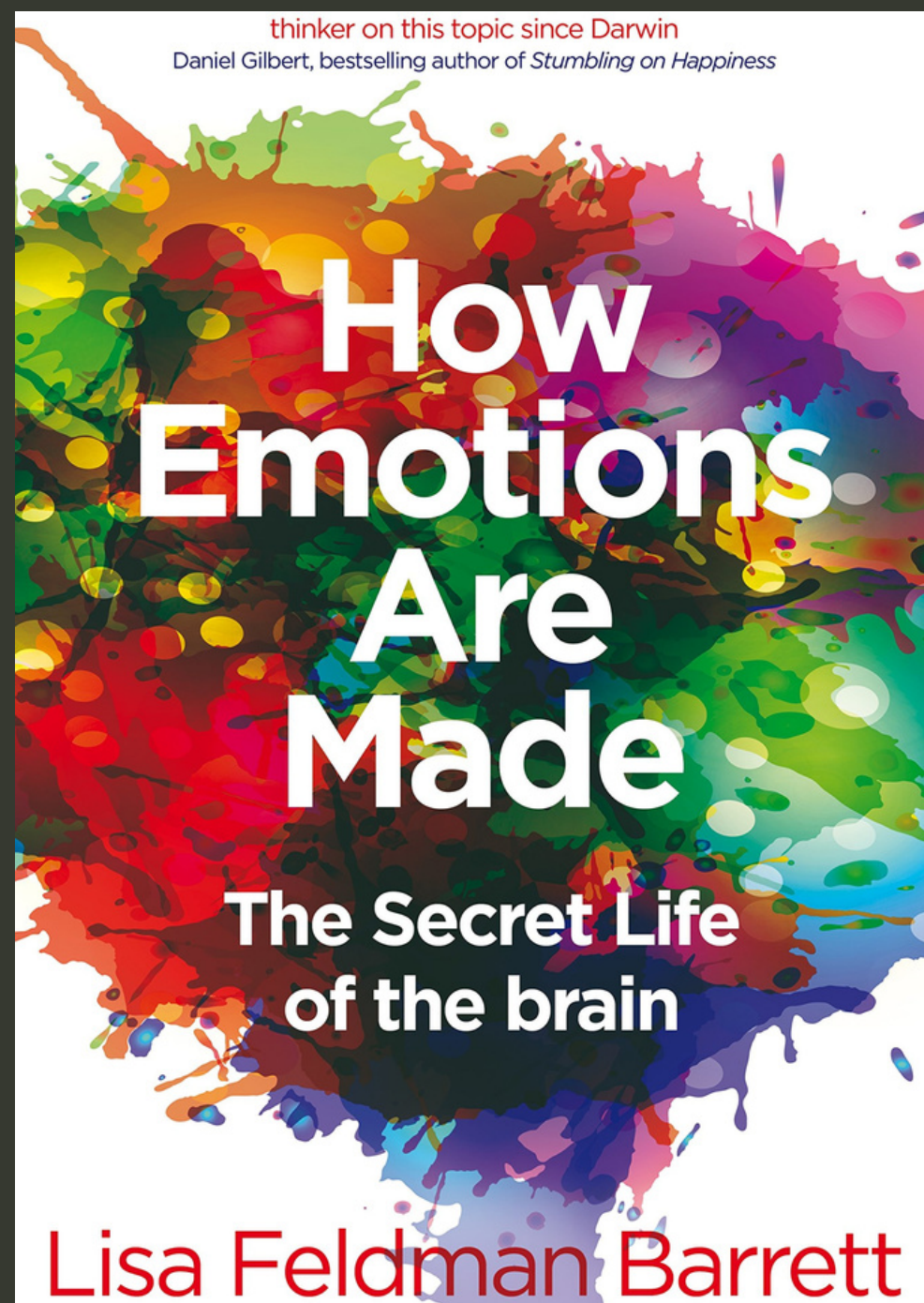

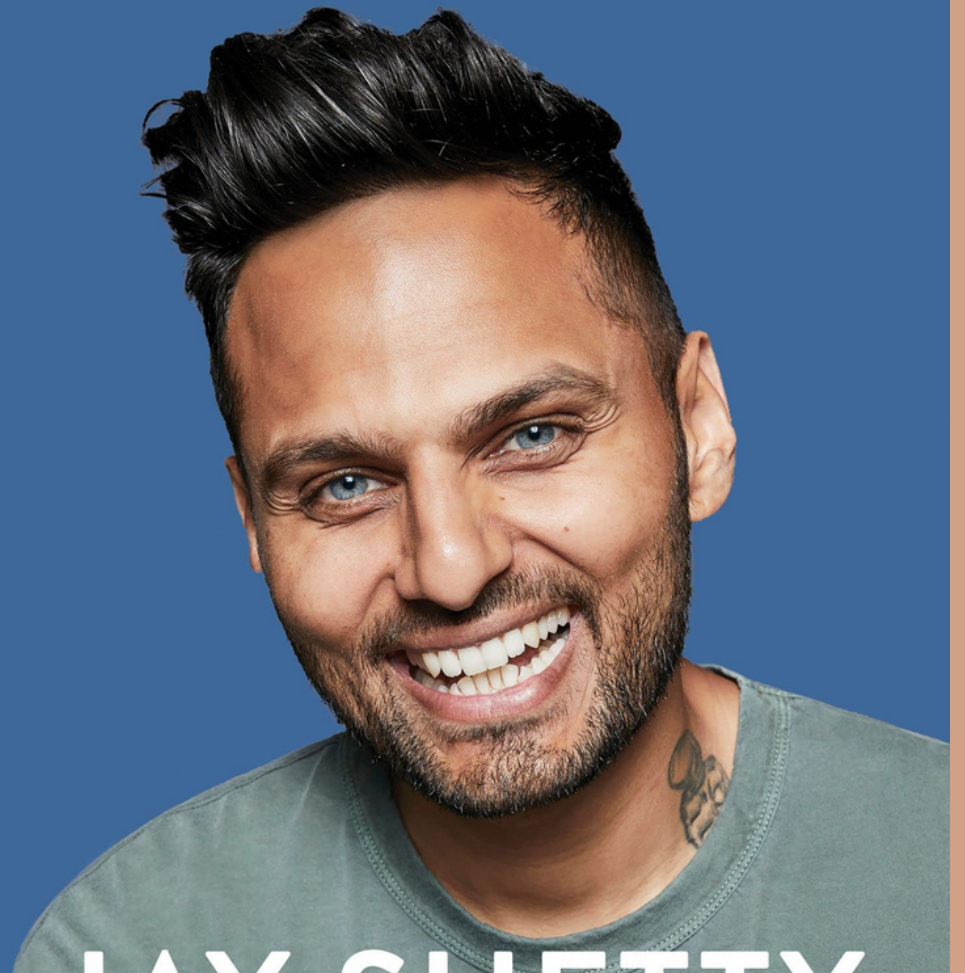
THINK LIKE A MONK

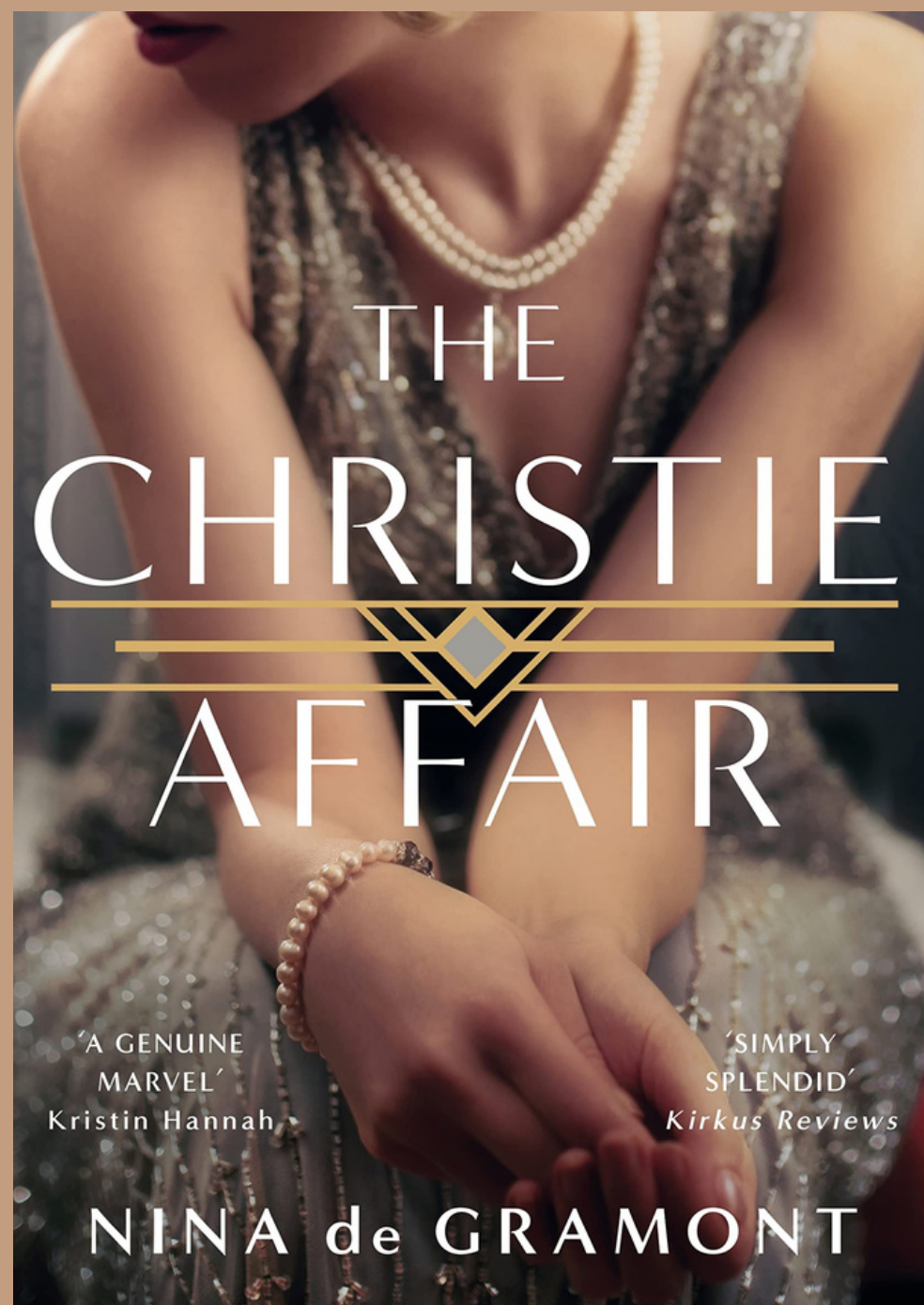
Agatha Christie's world is one of glamorous society parties, country house weekends, and growing literary fame.

The Christie Affair is a stunning novel that reimagines the unexplained eleven-day disappearance of Agatha Christie in 1926, which captivated the world.



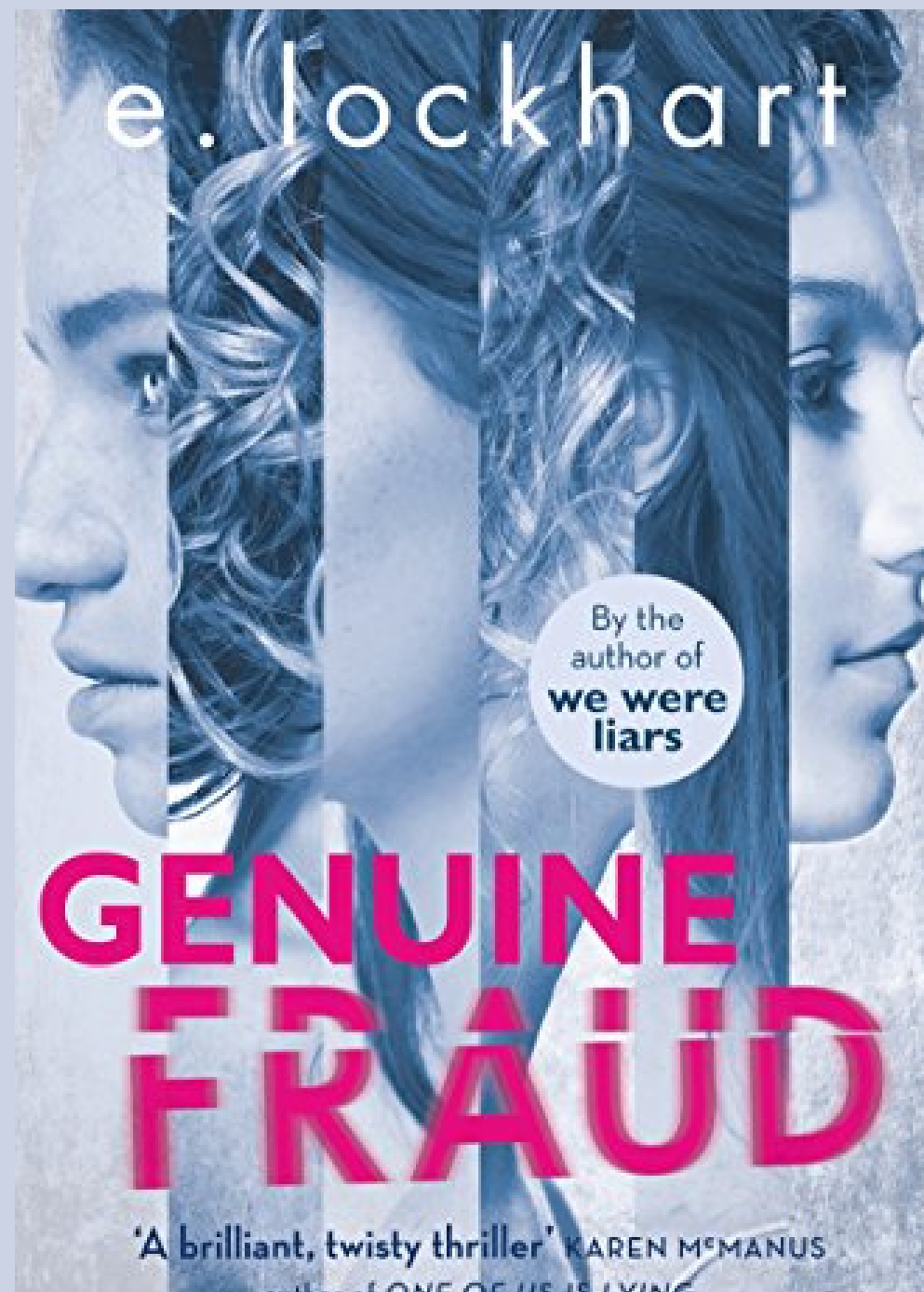

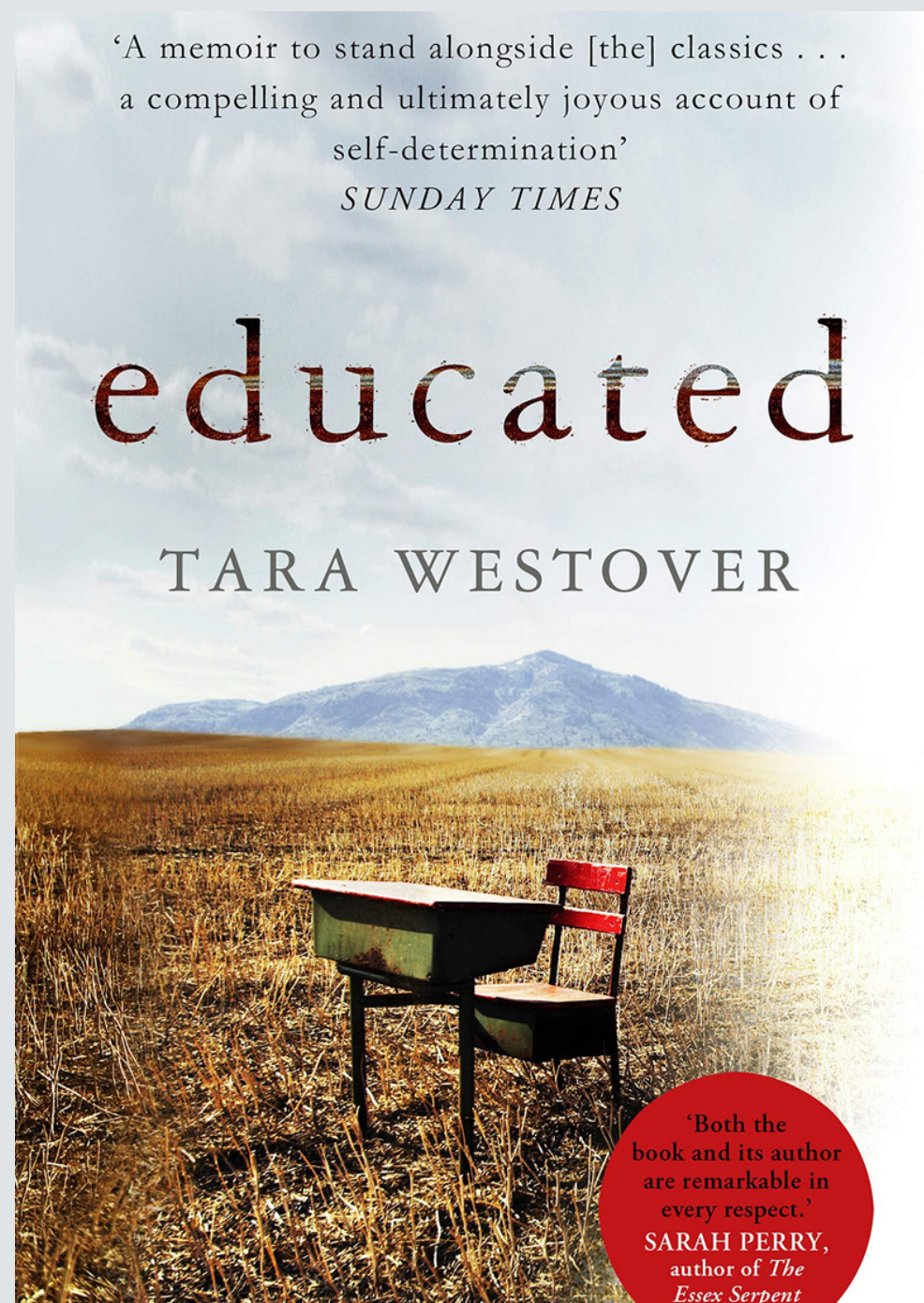
